Water Division has two pickups and an old welder that need to be declared surplus and sold.

The 1992 Ford Ranger 4x4, 4.0 L, automatic (VIN 1FTCR11X4NTA57246) has 127,000 miles on it. The 1994 GMC Sierra ½ T, 5.0 L, automatic (VIN 1GTED14H9RZ559025) has 192,000 miles. Both vehicles have transmissions that are not repairable.

The wire welder is a Lincoln, Model 250 Wirematic (serial #01941214483) purchased in 1995 and was replaced several years ago when the wire-feed mechanism failed.

The following action is requested:

**“I move that the 1992 Ford Ranger (T-58), the 1994 GMC Sierra (T-61) and the Lincoln welder (E-850) be declared surplus, that they be advertised for sale on a sealed-bid basis, and sold to the highest bidder on a salvage basis.”**
